SUBJECT: AZAPO ON THE INEFFECIENCY OF GOVERNMENT

The claim by the ruling party to create over two million jobs and accelerate service delivery rings hollow, when viewed against the millions of rands that are returned to treasury after failing to spend for service delivery.

The Limpopo government is said to have returned over a billion rand to treasury in unspent amounts from their allocated budget.

The Education Department returned R 523.3 million, while Black learners die in pit toilets and are forced to study under trees due to lack of classrooms and decent schools.

Health Department returned R 570.5 million when the poor Blacks who are loyal with their vote have a shortage of doctors and health practitioners, ambulances and medical suppliers.

The Public Works, Roads and Infrastructure department returned R 226.1 million, when the roads and infrastructure in the province leaves a lot to desire.

The youth that used to benefit from EPWP are rooming the streets unemployed and consumed by drugs.

The Agriculture Department returned R 98.7 million and the Social Development Department R 72.4 million, when programmes to create meaningful engagement for Black youth could have been undertaken to alleviate unemployment.

Nothing consolidated the call by **AZAPO** for the abolishing of provincial governments and legislatures than this overt mismanagement and inefficient capacity to do what the government was elected for - service delivery and pro-active human development.

AZAPO is warning our people to be circumspect with their vote and to consider a party like **AZAPO**,

which is committed to Black excellence and a deep sense of love for our people.
